Anti-Malice [#106]



Anti-Malice is a substance created by the Conspicuous Interaction Agency as a byproduct of the research into Malice. After the original outbreak at **Example 1999**, the Conspicuous Interaction Agency had to focus resources into research of the malice by taking samples of ripped Malice Puddles, most likely from water.

Research finds that Malice is made up of a compound that explodes when it comes into contact with water. Malice also tends to spread whenever living beings are involved, even though concentrations of water are still present. This is because the water concentrations are not high enough to be dangerous to Malice. In addition, the body cells could be hijacked to **Example 10**. The cells would then be dissolved to form more of the compound.

In response to this, the Conspicuous Interaction Agency created Anti-Malice, a substance that had similar properties to Malice, but has compounds that rip apart Malice but does not rip apart itself, much like water.

Field tests against Malice Puddles with Anti-Malice were beyond successful. Not only were Malice Puddles torn to shreds in response to the Anti-Malice, but the remnants of Malice Puddles were also morphed into Anti-Malice. This makes it a crucial tool for clearing Malice Puddles and treating infected individuals.
